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ACTION-FOR-HEALTH aims to improve the health and quality of life of European citizens by tackling health inequalities through health promotion.

This will be achieved by increasing the capacity of regional stakeholders to develop health promotion interventions and to access structural funds.

ACTION-FOR-HEALTH works intersectorally connecting Institutes of Public Health, Academic and Research Organisations, and Non-Governmental Organisations.



In **ACTION-FOR-HEALTH**, project partners will assess the public health situation in their countries, choose a specific region, develop a strategic document including an action plan aimed at improving identified health inequalities, and implement activities aimed at tackling one chosen objective.

ACTION-FOR-HEALTH contributes to reducing health inequalities by improving access to structural funds, using a culturally adjusted, multi-sectoral, strategic approach and application of health promotion.

ACTION-FOR-HEALTH connects 10 countries from the EU including: Bulgaria, Estonia, Hungary, Lithuania, Netherlands, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, the United Kingdom and Croatia.
