Survivor's Network: Local and national activism for survivors

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Abstract

Survivors' Network is a registered charity that aims to reduce sexual violence and its impact on survivors' lives. It consists of a small team of staff and volunteers who offer a range of services to survivors of any gender aged 14+ who have experienced any form of sexual violence. Services include a drop-in and helpline, one-to-one counselling, work specifically targeted at young people and an Independent Sexual Violence Advocacy (ISVA).

Survivor's Network also offers advice and information to professionals, friends, partners and family members supporting survivors and delivers training to external organisations on a range of topics related to sexual violence. Survivor's Network is contacted by 600 people every year.
